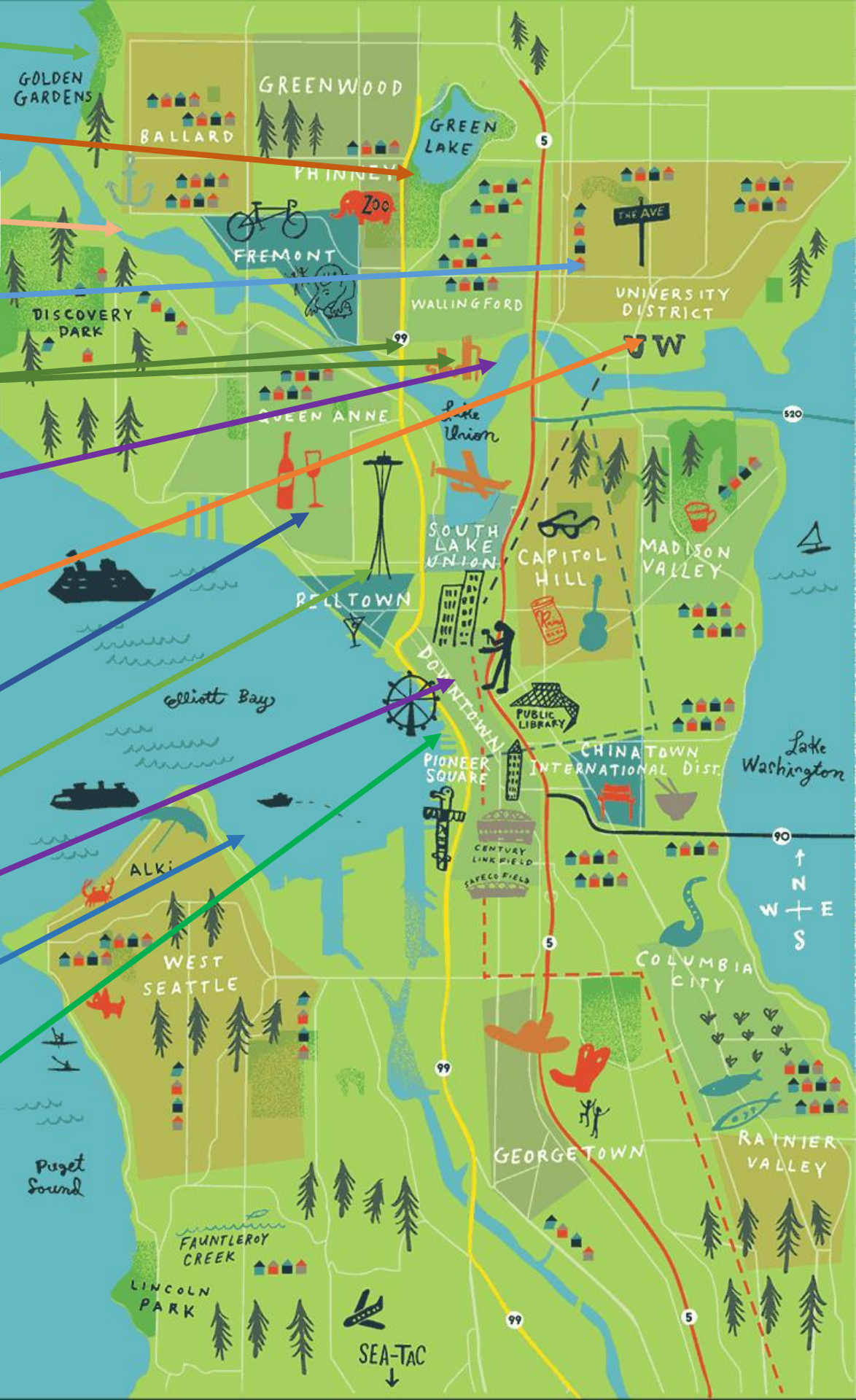


- Golden Gardens**

(Wedding venue) and Ivar's in case you're early!

Nicki's beautiful graduate alma mater; check out Agua Verde for food and kayaks

Great views at no cost
- Seattle Center**
Space Needle, Food and Museums
- Pike Place Market**
We Recommend NOT eating before you come here!
- Marination Ma Kai**
Take the water taxi from downtown for great Hawaiian food
- Ferry Terminal**
Easiest and cheapest way to get out on the Sound (~\$8)

Ballard

Great neighborhood with heaps of shops, restaurants and breweries (*most breweries per zip code in the country*).

- **Activities:** The Chittenden Locks and Fish Ladder is a great place to picnic and potentially see some precocious salmon
- **Breweries:** Stoup • Reubens • Populuxe (*carries Cider*) • Hilliards (they all usually have food trucks at them for feed options)
- **Restaurants:** Walrus and the Carpenter • Bitterroot • The Fat Hen • El Camión (*amazing tacos*) • King's Hardware • Bastille • Ray's Boathouse (*for a nice Patio onto the water*)
- **Shops:** Second Ascent (*classic PNW outdoors store*)

Green Lake

Cool neighborhood with a great lake for swimming / walking; close to rehearsal dinner:

- **Restaurants:** Green Lake Bar & Grill • the Shelter
- **Activities:** 3-mile run around the lake • mini-golf • boat rentals

Fremont

Quirky neighborhood that takes pride in it's weirdness. Loads of weird attractions and more coffee shops than you can shake a stick at!

- **Attractions:** Fremont Troll • Lenin Statue • Rocketship
- **Cafes:** Fremont Coffee (*get a latte to see some foam artwork*) • Milstead
- **Restaurants:** Agrodolce • Revel • Uneeda Burger • Paseo • RockCreek
- **Bars/Breweries:** Fremont Brewery (*Patio*) • Schilling Cider • Woodski's (*if you miss winter*)

Wallingford

Nice residential area with business strip on 45th and water to the South

- **Activities:** Check out Gasworks Park • Rent a SUP at Urban Surf • *Our Wedding!*
- **Restaurants:** Pacific Inn • Joule • Westward • Dick's Drive-In

South Lake Union

Home of Amazon!

- **Activities:** The MOHAI • Lake Union Park • Center for Wooden Boats (rent a kayak or canoe and tour around the lake • The Original REI store, which is gigantic and amazing • The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation Visitors Center – free tours held daily
- **Cafes:** Citizen Cafe • Uptown Espresso • Zoka Coffee Roasters
- **Restaurants:** Cask and Trotter • re:public • Bravehorse Tavern • Fierabend • The Wurst Place • Lunchbox Laboratory

University District

Very close to the wedding venue, lots of cheap eats and a shopping center to take care of any last-minute needs.

- **Restaurants:** Din Tai Fung • Korean Tofu House • Guanacos Tacos
- **Activities:** See where Nicki went to school; the campus is beautiful! • Head to University Village for shopping

Madison Park/Valley

Fancy neighborhood near the water

- **Activities:** Nice beach with warm swimming; Washington Park Arboretum • Seattle Japanese Garden
- **Restaurants:** Harvest Vine • Nishino

Queen Anne

Our neighborhood. Great views of the city, and some more casual places to checkout

- **Attractions:** Kerry Park and Marshall Park for views of Mt. Rainier/the city and the Olympic respectively; the walk between for amazing homes
- **Food/Drink:** Le Rêve bakery • Toulouse Petit • Mezcaleria Oaxaca • Hilltop Ale House

Capitol Hill

The cool neighborhood (*we rarely go there*); there's tons of good restaurants though, plenty of unique shops, and good nightlife if you're looking for it

- **Restaurants:** Taylor Shellfish Co. (*for happy hour oysters*) • Mamnoon • Sitka and Spruce • Annapurna Cafe • Monsson • Many others that we don't know about...!
- **Bars:** RockBox (*if you want Karaoke*) • Lots of others that we don't know about!

Bell Town

Apartment district just outside of downtown

- **Restaurants:** Local 360 • Shiro's • Blackbottle • Serious Pie • Spur Gastropub
- **Bars:** Bathtub Gin & Co.
- **Activities:** The Space Needle and Seattle Center • Chihuly Museum of Glass • The Experience Music Project • Olympic Sculpture Park

Downtown

General downtown area with market, shopping and waterfront

- **Attractions:** Pike Place Market • Waterfront (*though under construction now*) • The Plaza at the corner of 3rd and Pike has food trucks, cornhole, and childrens' activities
- **Shops:** Standard large department stores, the flagship Nordstroms
- **Restaurants:** Matts in the Market • Pike Place Chowder • Biscuit Bitch

Pioneer Square

One of the oldest neighborhoods in Seattle with classic old stone buildings

- **Activities:** The Seattle Underground Tour • Water Taxi to Alki (*Marination Ma Kai*) • Ferry to Bainbridge Island
- **Restaurants:** Hole in the Wall BBQ • Plenty of others
